



**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY BOARD
WILL COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

Authorizing the County Executive to Execute a Contract with Amplifund for Grant Management Software

WHEREAS, Will County is in need of Grant Management Software to responsibly allocate and track American Rescue Plan Act funding received from the Federal Government; and

WHEREAS, in order to obtain the best price for Grant Management Software, proposals were solicited; and

WHEREAS, on May 23, 2022, the Will County Executive's Office solicited proposals for Grant Management Software and received five (5) responses by the closing date of June 7, 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Will County Executive's Office and Anser Advisory reviewed the responses and conducted demonstrations with the five (5) respondents; and

WHEREAS, the Will County Executive's Office and Anser Advisory have recommended that a contract be entered into with the lowest responsible, responsive bidder, Amplifund, of Cleveland, OH, for a yearly cost of \$39,500.00, with a one-time activation of \$21,000.00, funding to be determined; and

WHEREAS, once the County has expended all the ARPA Funds, future funding for the Grant Management Software will need to be identified in the County Executive's budget.

NOW, THEREFORE IT BE RESOLVED, that the Will County Board hereby authorizes the County Executive to execute a contract for Grant Management Software with the lowest responsible, responsive bidder, Amplifund, of Cleveland, OH, for a yearly cost of \$39,500.00, with a one-time activation of \$21,000.00, funding to be determined.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, once the County has expended all the ARPA Funds, future funding for the Grant Management Software will need to be identified in the County Executive's budget.



Will County Executive Office identified a comprehensive software solution to support grant management of the funds received and administered through the Office. Specifically, the County pursued the solution to help the administration of the \$134 million allocation from the U.S. Department of the Treasury under the Coronavirus State and Local Fiscal Recovery Funds (SLFRF) program. As an entitlement community, Will County receives annual funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), coordinating and managing over \$4 million to facilitate municipal and capital infrastructure projects. Will County will accept applications and track hundreds of service providers (“Subrecipients”) they administer the funds. A key role is to manage grant applicants through a competitive procurement process and provide programmatic, fiscal, and technical assistance to Subrecipients.

Will County solicited bid submissions and received five responses at the bid opening on June 7:

1. Benevate Inc., DBA Neighborly Software
2. ECivis (GTY Technology)
3. Team Title, LLC DBA Team Civic Solutions (TCS)
4. StreamLink Software Inc. DBA AmpliFund
5. Fluxx Labs, Inc

Will County staff conducted a demonstration of the service with each respondent on the following dates/times:

1. Benevate Inc., DBA Neighborly Software - Thursday, June 16 at 1:15 pm
2. ECivis (GTY Technology) Friday, June 17 at 2 pm
3. Team Title, LLC DBA Team Civic Solutions (TCS) - Thursday, June 16 at 3 pm
4. StreamLink Software Inc. DBA AmpliFund - Friday, June 17 at 9 am
5. Fluxx Labs, Inc - Friday, June 24 at 2 pm

Staff selected Amplifund as the service meets all criteria. The primary factors for consideration were price, implementation timeframe, technical support, and user experience. It offers a tiered pricing model based on the annual grant revenue, which includes unlimited users with a yearly subscription totaling \$39,500. There is also a quoted one-time activation of \$21,000. Implementation with Amplifund will take 6 to 8 weeks with 24/7/365 technical support. Overall, staff felt the service was easy to use, straightforward to set up, and supported the variety of grant funds and programs the County administers.
