

## Stormwater Management Committee Awards Grants for 2011 Projects

The Will County Stormwater Management Planning Committee awarded the 2011 Project Grants to recipients. Three projects were selected county wide which included a mix of flood mitigation and water quality improvement projects.

“The Stormwater Committee is grateful that the County Board continues to support and fund this project program” said Scott Killinger, who chairs the Committee. “The projects funded this year will benefit the citizens of Will County by improving water quality in our streams, and by mitigating flooding in neighborhoods.”

This is the third year of the program. The Stormwater Project Program awards grant funds of up to 50% for projects that include flood mitigation and water quality improvement. Will County received three applications this year from two different local sponsors. The selected projects include:

- Prairie Creek Stream Debris Removal, Dralle Rd, Green Garden Township
- 88th Ave & Pauling Flood Control Project, Green Garden Township
- Honeytree/Marquette Business Park Grading Project, Village of Romeoville
