

Stormwater Management Committee Awards Grants for 2013 Projects

The Will County Stormwater Management Planning Committee awarded the 2013 Project Grants to recipients. Two projects were selected county wide which included a mix of flood mitigation and water quality improvement projects.

“The Stormwater Committee is grateful that the County Board continues to support and fund this project program” said Scott Killinger, who chairs the Committee. “The projects funded this year will benefit the citizens of Will County by improving water quality in our streams, and by mitigating flooding in neighborhoods.”

This is the fifth year of the program. The Stormwater Project Program awards grant funds of up to 50% for projects that include flood mitigation and water quality improvement. Will County received one application this year from a local sponsor. The Committee also resolved to fund expansion of the Will County Rain Gauge Network which is administered in partnership with the Illinois Department of Natural Resources. The selected projects include:

- Pheasant Ridge Sediment Removal Project, Naperville Township
- Rain Gage Network Expansion, various locations
