## Stormwater Management Committee Awards Grants for 2020 Projects

The Will County Stormwater Management Planning Committee awarded the 2020 Project Grants to recipients at their regular meeting on Tuesday, September 1, 2020. Twelve projects were selected, county wide, which included a mix of public safety, flood mitigation and water quality improvement projects.

The Will County County Board continues to support and fund the project program. The projects funded this year will benefit the citizens of Will County by reducing the amount of standing water on pavement, improving water quality in our streams, and by mitigating flooding in neighborhoods.

This is the twelfth year of the program. The Stormwater Project Program awards grant funds of up to 50% match with local sponsors. Will County received thirteen applications this year from twelve different local sponsors. The Will County Board budgeted \$150,000 for 2020 and the Stormwater Management Planning Committee was able to obligate the entire amount. The projects are:

Shell Lake, Phase 2 (Wheatland Township)

Stevens Lane Drainage (Village of Wilmington & Wilmington Township)

Doyle Road & Barr Road Culvert Replacement (Wilton Township)
