STREET, RECONSTRUCTION, INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS

The Will County Division of Transportation requires professional services from a qualified engineering firm to provide Design Engineering Services for roadway improvements along Briggs Street (CH 54) from the I-80 westbound ramps to Washington Street.

The attached **Project Description** and **Preliminary Scope of Services** provides a summary of major items potentially encountered during the course of the required design services. At this time, the County anticipates starting this work in late 2017, with an approximate twelve (12) to eighteen (18) months to complete the work.

I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Will County Division of Transportation (WCDOT) continues with the reconstruction of Briggs Street (CH 54). This project includes corridor capacity analysis, pavement removal and replacement, drainage improvements including new curb and gutter, sidewalk replacement, and ADA analysis / compliance design. The proposed improvement will generally consist of:

- Determining appropriate lane configuration
- The construction/reconstruction of existing pavement including curb and gutter
- The reconstruction of the sidewalk and ADA accessible ramps
- The modification of driveway access as necessary
- Traffic signal modifications at Washington Street

The project will be locally funded. Phase III Construction will be funded with local funds. This project will be completed under applicable IDOT guidelines including BLR and BDE Manuals and WCDOT standards.

II. PRELIMINARY PROJECT SCOPE

The Consultant will provide design engineering services including but not limited to the following:

- Traffic counts along the corridor and at each intersection. Make recommendation for pavement geometrics.
- Detailed topographic surveys
- Surveys for any right of way acquisitions or construction easements, and the preparation of plats and legal descriptions
- Soils/pavement investigation, as necessary, to determine roadway structural design, as well as CCDD screening
- Preparation of a project photo log of existing conditions
- Assist in obtaining permits from all regulatory agencies and updating of any clearances as required by the scope of the proposed improvements
- Estimates of Costs and Time
- Coordinate with the WCDOT, IDOT, Joliet Township Road District, City of Joliet, and other involved parties/agencies as necessary
- Preparation of contract plans and specifications
