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80th Avenue reconstruction - PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The WCDOT is improving the corridor of 80th Avenue from the intersection of 191st Street north to the intersection of 183rd Street near Tinley Park, IL. This project includes pavement reconstruction with additional through lanes, and other modernization items. The general list of improvements includes:

- Construction of a new detention basin inside the project limits
- Water main work for the Village of Tinley Park
- Removal of the existing structure carrying 80th Avenue over Union Ditch and construction of a new three-span bridge
- Removal of the existing two-lane I-80 overpass and construction of a new widened overpass
- Installation of Load Transfer Platform to support 80th Avenue on organic soils
- Construction of Hot Mix Asphalt pavement to accommodate two through lanes in each direction
- Construction of various left and right turn lanes at intersections and entrances
- Modernization of two traffic signals and the installation of one new signal
- Installation of new Noise Abatement Walls in various parts of the project

80th Avenue reconstruction – CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING PROJECT SCOPE

Tasks or requirements including, but not limited to:

- The Consultant should have in possession an IDOT prequalification in the following categories:

Special Services – Surveying	Special Services – Construction Inspection
Structures – Highway Typical	Special Services – Quality Assurance Testing
Special Services – Public Involvement	Geotechnical Services
- The named Resident Construction Supervisor (Resident Engineer) for the project shall be a licensed Professional Engineer in the state of Illinois
- The Resident Engineer's Staff should be adequately sized for the scope of the project
- The IDOT construction contract will be let at the State and will use Federal funds for construction
- The Resident Engineer and/or the Staff shall be able to move the project through all stages of construction, including proper documentation and Contractor payment using the IDOT Construction & Materials Management System
- The Staff shall handle the required processing of Americans With Disabilities Act forms for the sidewalk and multi-use paths included with the project
- The Staff shall be able to adequately handle extensive coordination with IDOT during the work occurring on, above, or around the Expressway
- The Staff shall be able to handle the reporting requirements for the existing ACOE permit
- The Staff shall be able to adequately handle required coordination with IDOT, Cook County, the Village of Tinley Park and the public stakeholders affected by the project
- Any further requirements which may be needed to complete an IDOT Construction Engineering Agreement provisions
