Bell Road reconstruction - PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The WCDOT is improving part of the Bell Road corridor from north of the intersection of 159th Street north to the intersection of 151st Street in Homer Glen, IL. This project includes pavement reconstruction with additional through lanes on a new alignment and signal modernizations. The general list of improvements includes:

- Construction of a new detention basin inside the project limits
- Construction of Hot Mix Asphalt pavement on a slight re-alignment to accommodate two through lanes in each direction
- Construction of various left and right turn lanes at intersections and entrances
- Installation of new traffic signal at the Meadowview Lane intersection
- Installation of new Noise Abatement Walls in various parts of the project

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Bell Road reconstruction – CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING PROJECT SCOPE

Tasks or requirements including, but not limited to:

- The Consultant should have an IDOT prequalification in the following categories, but a Consultant may also utilize sub-consultants as needed to fulfill these requirements:

Special Services – Surveying	Special Services – Construction Inspection
Structures – Highway Typical	Special Services – Quality Assurance Testing
Special Services – Public Involvement	Geotechnical Services
- Be advised, the field work associated with the relocation of utilities in advance of the road construction will be overseen by in-house County staff
- The named Resident Construction Supervisor (Resident Engineer) for the project shall be a licensed Professional Engineer in the state of Illinois
- The Resident Engineer's Staff should be adequately sized for the scope of the project
- The IDOT construction contract will be let at the State and will use Federal funds for construction
- The Resident Engineer and/or the Staff shall be able to move the project through all stages of construction, including proper documentation and Contractor payment using the IDOT Construction & Materials Management System
- The Staff shall handle the required processing of Americans With Disabilities Act forms for the sidewalk and multi-use paths included with the project
- The Staff shall be able to handle the reporting requirements for the existing ACOE permit
- The Staff shall be able to adequately handle required coordination with IDOT, the Village of Homer Glen, Homer CCSD-33C, and the public stakeholders affected by the project
- Any further requirements which may be needed to complete an IDOT Construction Engineering Agreement provisions
