The Will County Division of Transportation requires professional services from a qualified engineering consultant to provide Phase I (Preliminary Engineering)/II (Design Engineering) Services for safety improvements for Exchange Street (CH 49) at its intersection of Burville Road.

The attached **Project Description** and **Preliminary Scope of Services** provides a summary of major items potentially encountered during the course of the required Phase I/II services. At this time the County anticipates starting this work in winter 2020 (subject to IDOT execution of LA Agreement), with an approximate twenty-four (24) months to complete the work.

I. PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Will County Division of Transportation (WCDOT) study, in partnership with the Crete Township Road District, will determine what the needs are to improve the intersection as required per the current State and Federal requirements. The project is anticipated to be processed as a Categorical Exclusion and determination of appropriate documentation is required. When Design Approval is received, the firm will be given the notice to proceed for the Phase II contract documents. This project will be completed under applicable IDOT guidelines including BLR and BDE Manuals and WCDOT standards.

Engineering and construction are Federally funded through a Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant.

Experience with HSIP funding and the associated documentation required for selection. In addition, experience with roundabout design a plus.

II. PRELIMINARY PROJECT SCOPE

The Consultant will provide Phase I/II engineering services including but not limited to the following:

 - Environmental Survey Request forms and attachments
 - Attendance at Project Kick-off Meeting(s)
- Data Collection
 - County will provide crash data records, existing plans, aerial mapping as needed.
 - Consultant will:
 - Perform any required traffic counts
 - Obtain information such as utilities from outside agencies
 - Prepare project photo log of existing conditions.
- Field Survey
 - Detailed topographic surveys for development of construction documents
 - Surveys for any right of way acquisitions and construction easements
- Analysis of Traffic and Crash Data
- Environmental Studies
 - Wetland Delineation Report
 - Special Waste Survey
- Preliminary Design
- Intersection Design Studies
- Soils/pavement investigation, as necessary, to determine roadway structural design, as well as CCDD screening
- Drainage and Hydraulic Studies
- Attendance at FHWA/Bureau of Local Roads Coordination Meeting(s)
- Public Involvement
- Project Development Report – or appropriate processing as determined.
- Estimates of Costs and Time
- Assist in obtaining permits from all regulatory agencies and updating of any clearances as required by the scope of the proposed improvements
