




Coroner of Will County, Illinois

The Office of the Will County Coroner is a law enforcement agency, which, as part of the system of checks and balances, investigates deaths outlined by state statutes that occur within the county. Also by Statute, the Coroner is a law enforcement official, and has those additional responsibilities as outlined by the Statutes. When a Deputy Coroner acts on behalf of the Coroner, he or she acts with the same authority, and has the same responsibility, as the Coroner.

It is the purpose of this office to do professional death investigations. We want to do this by making a commitment to “care of the deceased and concern for the living”.

We recognize we must work within the economic framework prescribed to us by the Will County Board. The 2019 operating budget for the Will County Coroner’s Office is \$2,224,362. At this time the Will County Coroner’s office has the following employees and divisions:



We have two separate locations, the administrative office is located at 158 N. Scott St., in Joliet, Illinois and the morgue facility is located at 1240 Caton Farm Rd., in Crest Hill, Illinois.

No documents will be made available until that review is completed within the period allotted under the Freedom of Information Act.
